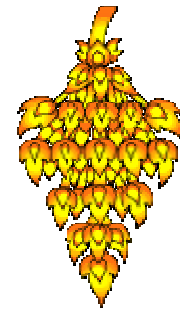


# Marriage Registration under Thai Laws



## Basic conditions

- Must be 17 year old or over.
- If the application is between 17 – 20 year old ,his or her parent must give their consent in written to the registrar.
- The couple must not share the same parent or same father or mother.
- Does not have mental illness.
- Widow can register her new marriage only after 310 days since divorce, unless ;
  - Giving birth during that period.
  - Remarriage with the same husband.
  - Having medical certificate proving that she doesn't pregnant.

## Document (for Czechs)

1. Valid passport
2. Marital Certificate issued by Czech authority, legalized by Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Czech Embassy in Thailand , then translated into Thai and legalized by Consular Department , Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.
3. In case getting marriage at Thai Embassy, the said marital certificate must be legalized by Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs and then translated officially into English or Thai.
4. For Czech widow, the medical certificate will be required if register her marriage before completing 310 days after divorce.

## Place to register marriage

1. Any districts (amphur) in Thailand.
2. Royal Thai Embassy or Thai Consulate General where the applicant has his or her permanent residence or nationality.

**Note :** *The marriage registration done by Thai Embassies and Consulates is governed by Thai Civil and Commercial Law and has its legal effect throughout the territory of the Kingdom of Thailand as well as the countries where this marriage registration is recognized.*
